**1. Description of Plan**

The following brief description of the T C Construction Company, Inc. Health and Welfare Trust Fund (the "Plan") is provided for general information purposes only. For additional information concerning the Plan's provisions, participants should refer to the Summary Plan Description.

**General**

The Plan is a self-insured health and welfare benefit plan established by T C Construction Company, Inc. (the "Company" or "Employer") on January 1, 2018, to provide certain welfare benefits to eligible employees and to their dependents. The Company self-insures these benefits from the general assets of the Company as well as through insurance contracts to pay certain benefits to employees and their dependents during any Plan year. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

**Benefits**

The Plan provides health benefits (medical, dental, vision and prescriptions) for eligible employees of the Company and their dependents. Prescription drug benefits are covered by the Medicare Prescription Drug, Improvement and Modernization Act of 2003. All covered employees receive life insurance coverage. The life insurance benefit is funded by a life insurance contract purchased by the Plan. The Plan also provides health benefits to certain active and retired members if they have accumulated, in the current year, credit amounts in excess of hours required for current coverage.

In accordance with the Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (COBRA), the Plan provides for continuation of benefits for certain terminated employees up to eighteen (18) months. The cost of these benefits is paid by the terminated employees or their dependents.

The Plan includes a cafeteria arrangement maintained pursuant to Section 125 of the Internal Revenue Code in which employees can elect to reduce their taxable salary in favor of purchasing non-taxable benefits.

**Eligibility**

Hourly employees will become eligible for coverage on the first of the month after 60 days from the date of hire, assuming that a minimum number of hours are worked during the two-month period. Contributions are made from the first eligible hour worked.

**Contributions**

The Company makes contributions to the Plan of a specified amount for each hour worked to fund the health claims payable, insurance premiums, other voluntary benefits, and administrative expenses. Additional contributions are received from terminated employees to continue their benefits under the COBRA provisions. The Company receives reimbursements from the stop-loss carrier when claims exceed predetermined deductible thresholds, which are used to reduce the Plan's losses. Stop-loss recoveries of \$266,156 were received by the Plan during the year ended December 31, 2024.

**Contributions (Continued)**

The Plan receives contributions from the Employer based on withholdings taken from employees per salary reduction elections as provided by Section 125 of the Internal Revenue Code.

**2. Significant Accounting Policies**

**Basis of Accounting**

The financial statements of the Plan have been prepared on the accrual basis of accounting which is in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAP). Employee and Employer contributions were recognized in the period that contributions are due.

**Estimates**

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires the Plan administrator to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets, benefit obligations and changes therein, claims incurred but not reported (IBNR), claims payable, liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

**Benefit Obligations**

The Plan liability for estimated health claims incurred but not reported is calculated using a "lag matrix formula", which calculates the average lag time between when a medical claim is incurred and when it is actually submitted to the Plan for payment. This lag time is then applied to the claims submitted to the Plan for payment during the year and the result is the estimated health claims incurred during the Plan year that will be submitted for payment following the end of the Plan year when it is actually paid by the Plan. Health claims payable and claims incurred but not reported totaled \$110,794 and \$281,753 at December 31, 2024 and 2023, respectively.

The Plan liability for Accumulated Eligibility Credits is based on a monthly prevailing wage contribution per hour by the employer, and reduced by a calculation for medical premiums, subject to a maximum balance per employee of \$2,000.

**Benefits**

Benefits are recorded when incurred.

**Subsequent Events**

In preparing these financial statements, the Plan has evaluated events and transactions for potential recognition or disclosure through January 14, 2026, the date the financial statements were available to be issued.

**3. Administrative Expenses**

The Plan has agreements with various service providers to provide administrative services, claims adjudication, COBRA administration and other services. In addition, the Plan pays fees for services provided through other contracts. Administrative expenses consist of the following for the year ended December 31, 2024:

**4. Termination of the Plan**

Under certain conditions, the Plan may be terminated. Although the Company has not expressed an intention to do so, upon termination the remaining assets shall be subject to the applicable provisions of the Plan then in effect and shall be used until exhausted to pay benefits to employees in the order of their entitlement.

**5. Income Taxes**

The Plan received a favorable determination letter from the Internal Revenue Service stating that the Plan meets the requirements for qualification under Section 501(c)(9) of the Internal Revenue Code and, as such, is exempt from taxation. The Plan has also received a determination letter from the Franchise Tax Board and is exempt under Section 23701(i).

The Plan believes that it has appropriate support for any tax positions taken, and as such, does not have any uncertain tax positions that are material to the financial statements.

**6. Related Party and Party in Interest Transactions**

The Company withholds and remits participant contributions to the Plan, and remits contributions in sufficient amounts in order for the Plan to pay all premiums and claims processed by the third-party administrator. In addition, the Plan has a number of service providers which are parties in interest under ERISA. These transactions are related party and party in interest transactions as applicable. The Company makes additional contributions to the Plan for the payment of these expenses.

**7. Cash Concentration**

The Plan maintains its cash with one financial institution deemed to be creditworthy. The Plan's cash is insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation ("FDIC") up to the legal limits. The Plan has not experienced any losses on its cash deposit.


