Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of the John Brown University Health Benefit Trust (the Plan), an employee benefit plan subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA). The financial statements comprise the statements of net assets available for benefits-cash basis as of May 31, 2025 and 2024, and the related statement of changes in net assets available for benefits-cash basis for the year ended May 31, 2025, and the related notes to the financial statements.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the net assets available for benefits of the Plan as of May 31, 2025 and 2024, and the changes in its net assets available for benefits for the year ended May 31, 2025, in accordance with the basis of accounting described in Note 2.

Basis for Opinion

1. DESCRIPTION OF THE PLAN:

The following description of John Brown University Health Benefit Trust (the Plan) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan Document for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions and its amendments.

GENERAL

John Brown University (the University) established the Plan on February 20, 1993. The Plan qualifies as an Employees Welfare Benefit Trust (EWBT) and a Single-Employer Benefit Arrangement (SEBA) pursuant to the Internal Revenue Code. The Plan was established under Section 403 of the Employee Retirement Security Act of 1974 (ERISA) and as such is subject to the provisions of ERISA, as amended. The cabinet and board of trustees are responsible for oversight of the Plan, and the employee benefits committee determines the Plan's investment offerings and monitors investment performance.

BENEFITS

The Plan is a partially insured benefit plan providing group health insurance, dental insurance, and prescription drug coverage. Substantially all full-time employees and their dependents of the University are eligible to participate in the Plan. Retired employees who are not eligible for Medicare coverage are eligible for full participation in the Plan. Once the retiree is eligible for Medicare coverage, they may only participate in the dental portion of the plan. For the year ended May 31, 2025, Meritain Health, Inc., as plan administrator, processed claims on behalf of the participants.

The medical and prescription drug portions of the Plan are reinsured through excess loss insurance. Aggregate excess loss insurance is set at 125 percent of expected claims for the policy period. At the beginning of the Plan year, the expected claims were \$3,126,716 based on an enrollment count of 123 employees electing single coverage and 138 employees electing family coverage. There is a maximum aggregate benefit per term of \$1,000,000. The excess loss insurance covers claims for a single participant in excess of \$130,000, and an aggregating specific of \$40,000 is also included. Maximum specific lifetime benefit per person is unlimited.

CONTRIBUTIONS

Contributions paid by employees are determined by the Plan on a periodic basis as communicated to participants at the time of their elections. An employee may also contribute specified amounts to extend health and dental coverage to eligible dependents of the employee. The Plan may change the amount of contributions required of participants from time to time at its discretion. Retirees and terminated employees electing COBRA insurance coverage are responsible for the payment of their premiums. There are no current employees with post-retirement benefits.

CONTRIBUTIONS, continued

The Plan agreement provides that the University make monthly contributions to the Plan for each employee as determined annually by the Plan's trustees. For the year ended May 31, 2025, the contribution rate per employee per month for medical benefits was \$507 and \$37 for dental benefits. The University also contributed \$429 per month for spousal coverage, \$271 per month for children coverage, and \$705 per month for family coverage for the year ended May 31, 2025. The Plan also includes a high-deductible plan option. The monthly contribution rates paid by the University for the high-deductible plan option are \$469 for the employee, \$412 for spousal coverage, \$266 for children coverage, and \$675 per month for family coverage for the year ended May 31, 2025.

PLAN CHANGES AND TERMINATIONS

The Plan's trustees reserve the right to terminate, suspend, or amend the Plan at any time, in whole or in part, including making modifications to the benefits under this Plan. In the event the Plan is terminated, coverage ends on that date, and the rights of participants are limited to covered expenses incurred before the participant receives notice of termination. The Plan may be terminated at any time.

ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES

Administrative expenses to third-party administrators and other professionals for the year ended May 31, 2025, were \$224,058.

Certain employees of the University perform administrative services on behalf of the Plan and are not compensated by the Plan for these services.

2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

CASH BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The financial statements of the Plan have been prepared on the cash basis of accounting. Accordingly, receivables and accounts payable have not been recorded in the financial statements. Also, income is recorded when received and expenses recorded when paid.

CASH AND CASH EQUIVALENTS

Cash and cash equivalents represent amounts held in an interest bearing checking account and short term certificates of deposit. At May 31, 2025 and 2024, the Plan's cash balances exceeded federally insured limits by approximately \$2,240,000 and \$2,220,000, respectively.

CERTIFICATES OF DEPOSIT

The Plan holds certificates of deposit as of May 31, 2025, with maturity dates greater than three months. These are held at cost basis on the statements of net assets available for benefits due to the Plan's reporting on cash basis. Interest income is recorded on the cash basis of accounting.

PAYMENT OF BENEFITS

Health claims and premiums are reported when paid. Any refunds due to overpayments, subrogation, or adjustments are recorded in the period received and are shown netted with benefit payments.

3. PLAN BENEFIT OBLIGATIONS:

The Plan had estimated health claims incurred but not reported of approximately \$215,000 as of May 31, 2025. The estimate is calculated using a lag analysis of past claims. Under the cash basis of accounting, these benefit obligations are not reflected in these financial statements.

4. TAX STATUS:

The Plan has been established by the University as a formal plan. While a tax determination or ruling letter has not been obtained from the Internal Revenue Service, the sponsor believes the Plan's income to be tax exempt under this design. The Plan sponsor believes that the trust as amended continues to qualify and to operate in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Internal Revenue Code. The University is to hold, invest, reinvest, and otherwise administer the funds of the Plan.

5. PARTIES-IN-INTEREST:

Meritain, Inc. and Delta Dental Plan of Arkansas (Delta) provide administrative services for the Plan and receive compensation for their services; therefore, these transactions qualify as party-in-interest transactions. Total fees paid by the Plan to Meritain, Inc. and Delta were \$120,436 and \$21,693, respectively, for the year ended May 31, 2025.



