Management is also responsible for maintaining a current Plan instrument, including all Plan amendments; administering the Plan; and determining that the Plan's transactions that are presented and disclosed in the financial statements are in conformity with the Plan's provisions, including maintaining sufficient records with respect to each of the participants, to determine the benefits due or which may become due to such participants.

***Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements***

Except as described in the Scope and Nature of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) Audit section of our report, our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditors' report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not absolute assurance and therefore is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control. Misstatements are considered material if there is a substantial likelihood that, individually or in the aggregate, they would influence the judgment made by a reasonable user based on the financial statements.

Our audits did not extend to the certified investment information, except for obtaining and reading the certifications, comparing the certified investment information with the related information presented and disclosed in the financial statements, and reading the disclosures relating to the certified investment information to assess whether they are in accordance with the presentation and disclosure requirements of accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

Accordingly, the objective of an ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit is not to express an opinion about whether the financial statements as a whole are presented fairly, in all material respects, in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

We are required to communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit, significant audit findings, and certain internal control-related matters that we identified during the audit.

***Supplemental Schedules Required by ERISA***

The information included in the supplemental schedules, other than that agreed to or derived from the certified investment information, has been subjected to auditing procedures applied in the audits of the financial statements and certain additional procedures, including comparing and reconciling such information directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements or to the financial statements themselves, and other additional procedures in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. For information included in the supplemental schedules that agreed to or is derived from the certified investment information, we compared such information to the related certified investment information.

### **1. Description of Plan**

The following description of the Liberty Management Union 401(k) Plan (the "Plan") provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan document or summary plan description for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

#### ***General***

The Plan is a defined contribution plan covering substantially all union employees of Liberty Behavioral Management Corp. (the "Company"). Unionized employees of the Company are eligible to participate in the Plan upon completion of certain age and service requirements, as set forth in the Plan document. Employees who are age twenty-one or older become eligible to participate in elective deferrals after working three consecutive months of service. The Plan excludes non-resident aliens and residents of Puerto Rico. Nonunionized employees, not covered under a collective bargaining agreement, are eligible to participate in a separate plan sponsored by the Company. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 ("ERISA"). The Plan's management is responsible for oversight of the Plan. The Investment Committee determines the appropriateness of the Plan's investment offerings, monitors investment performance and reports to the Board of Directors.

#### ***Contributions***

The Plan permits participants to contribute up to 100% of their eligible compensation up to the maximum limits on participant contributions set forth by the Internal Revenue Code ("IRC"). In addition, there are further limitations on contributions made by highly compensated employees. Participants must contribute at least 1% of eligible compensation to the Plan. There is no automatic enrollment. Participants may designate all or a portion of their deferral contributions as after-tax contributions into a Roth account. Participants who have attained age 50 before the end of the plan year are eligible to make catch-up contributions. Participants may also contribute amounts representing distributions from other qualified defined benefit or defined contribution plans (rollover).

Although the Plan does not provide for employer matching contributions, the Company may make a contribution in order to satisfy special nondiscrimination rules that apply to the Plan.

Participants direct the investment of all contributions into various investment options offered by the Plan. Contributions are subject to certain Internal Revenue Service ("IRS") limitations.

#### ***Participant Accounts***

Each participant's account is credited with the participant's contribution and the Company's contribution, if applicable, as well as an allocation of the Plan's earnings (losses). Allocations are based on participant earnings, account balances or specific participant transactions, as defined in the Plan document.

#### ***Vesting***

Participants are immediately vested in their contributions plus actual earnings thereon.

#### ***Vesting (continued)***

#### ***Notes Receivable from Participants***

Participants may borrow from their accounts a minimum of \$1,000 up to a maximum equal to the lesser of \$50,000 or 50% of their account balance. Only one loan may be outstanding at any given time. The loans are secured by the balance in the participant's account. Interest is charged at a rate of prime plus 1% on the first business day of the month in which the loan is originated. Principal and interest is paid ratably through payroll deductions. Terms range from one to five years or greater for the purchase of a primary residence.

#### ***Payment of Benefits***

On termination of service due to death, disability, retirement or other reasons, a participant may receive a lump-sum distribution equal to the value of the participant's interest in their account. In-service distributions are permitted for participants who have attained the age of 59 ½. In addition, the Plan allows for hardship distributions if certain criteria are met.

#### ***Plan Expense Account***

The Plan entered into a service-based pricing arrangement whereby a portion of the revenue earned by certain Plan investments is passed through to the Plan for payment of permitted Plan expenses. The Plan Expense Account is a nonparticipant directed account within the Plan. At December 31, 2024 and 2023, the Plan Expense Account balance was \$85 and \$81. During 2024, no revenue was received by the Plan or used to reduce Plan expenses.

#### ***Net Transfers to Related Plans***

During the year ended December 31, 2024, the Plan had participants transfer to or from the Liberty Management Non-Union Employee Stock Ownership 401(k) Plan ("ESOP 401(k) Plan") due to employment status changes (i.e. union vs non-union). The plan sponsor for the ESOP 401(k) Plan is Liberty Behavioral Management Group, Inc., the parent of the Company.

### 2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

#### ***Basis of Accounting and Use of Estimates***

The accompanying financial statements have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (“U.S. GAAP”), which requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and changes therein, and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

#### ***Fair Value Measurements***

The Plan follows U.S. GAAP guidance on *Fair Value Measurements* which defines fair value and establishes a fair value hierarchy organized into three levels based upon the input assumptions used in pricing assets. Level 1 inputs have the highest reliability and are related to assets with unadjusted quoted prices in active markets. Level 2 inputs relate to assets with other than quoted prices in active markets which may include quoted prices for similar assets or liabilities or other inputs which can be corroborated by observable market data. Level 3 inputs are unobservable and are used to the extent that observable inputs do not exist.

Pursuant to U.S. GAAP guidance, alternative investments where fair value is measured using the Net Asset Value (“NAV”) per share as a practical expedient is not categorized within the fair value hierarchy.

#### ***Investment Valuation and Income Recognition***

All of the Plan’s investments are stated at fair value except for the investment contract, which is stated at contract value. The investment contract is stated at contract value, which represents contributions made under the contract, plus earnings, less participant withdrawals and administrative expenses. The common/collective trusts are valued at the NAV of units held by the Plan. The NAVs, as provided by the trustees, are used as a practical expedient to estimate fair value. The NAVs are based on the fair value of the underlying investments held by the funds less their liabilities. The practical expedient is not used when it is determined to be probable that a fund will sell the investment for an amount different than the reported NAV. The mutual funds and money market fund are valued at the daily closing price as reported by the fund. The funds held by the Plan are open-end funds that are registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission. These funds are required to publish their daily NAV and to transact at that price. These funds are deemed to be actively traded.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend date. Net appreciation in value of investments includes the gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year.

#### ***Notes Receivable from Participants***

Notes receivable from participants are measured at their unpaid principal balance plus any accrued but unpaid interest. Related fees are recorded as administrative expenses and are expensed when they are incurred. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis.

#### ***Payment of Benefits***

Benefits are recorded when paid.

#### ***Expenses***

Certain expenses related to maintaining the Plan are paid by the Company and are excluded from these financial statements. Plan service charges are included in administrative expenses on the statement of changes in net assets available for benefits. Investment related expenses are included in net appreciation in value of investments.

#### ***Subsequent Events Evaluation by Management***

Management has evaluated subsequent events for disclosure and/or recognition in the financial statements through the date that the financial statements were available to be issued, which date is January 20, 2026.

### 3. Information Certified (Unaudited)

Certain information related to investments and notes receivable from participants disclosed in the accompanying financial statements and ERISA-required supplemental Schedule H, Part IV, Line 4i – Schedule of Assets (Held at End of Year), including investments and notes receivable from participants held at December 31, 2024 and 2023, and net appreciation in value of investments, interest and dividends, and interest income on notes receivable from participants for the year ended December 31, 2024, was obtained by management and agreed to or derived from information certified as complete and accurate by Empower Trust Company, LLC, Empower Life & Annuity Insurance Company of New York, and Empower Annuity Insurance Company of America, qualified institutions.

#### ***Investment Contract***

The SAGIC Diversified Bond II (“SAGIC”) is a fully benefit responsive market value separate account investment option with a general investment account guarantee that provides a stated rate of return and insulates plan participant activity from daily fluctuations in the market. SAGIC was issued by Massachusetts Mutual Life Insurance Company. Under the terms of the SAGIC group annuity contract, participants may direct Plan-permitted withdrawal and/or transfer transactions of all or a portion of their balance in the SAGIC investment option at contract value. Contract value is the relevant measure for fully benefit-responsive investment contracts because this is the amount received by participants if they were to initiate permitted transactions under the terms of the Plan.

The plan administrator does not believe there are any events that are probable of occurring that might limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the contract issuer and that also would limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the participants.

SAGIC represented approximately 12% and 15% of the Plan’s net assets available for benefits at December 31, 2024 and 2023.

#### ***Common/Collective Trusts***

The Plan investments include 7 common/collective trusts (the “Trusts”) with Great Gray Trust Company, LLC, the trustee of the Trusts. Units of the Trusts are valued each day on which the New York Stock Exchange (“NYSE”) is open for trading in accordance with the valuation procedures established by the trustee. The NAV per unit is calculated as of the close of trading on the NYSE (generally, 4:00 p.m. U.S. Eastern time). The NAV per unit is computed by dividing the total fair value of the assets of each Trust, less its liabilities, by the total number of units outstanding at the time of such computation. Investment income earned is reinvested in each Trust and included in the determination of unit values. The Trusts sell new units and repurchase outstanding units on a daily basis. Unit purchases and redemptions are transacted at the NAV per fee class of the Trusts determined as of the close of business each day. The Trusts have no unfunded commitments as of December 31, 2024 and 2023.

### 5. Income Tax Status

The Plan's prototype plan document preparer has obtained an opinion letter dated November 14, 2022 from the IRS stating that the Plan is designed in accordance with applicable sections of the IRC. Although the Plan has been amended since receiving the opinion letter, the plan administrator believes that the Plan is currently being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the IRC.

U.S. GAAP requires plan management to evaluate tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability if the Plan has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the IRS. The Plan is subject to routine examinations by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no examinations for any tax periods in progress.

### 6. Plan Termination

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Company has the right to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA.

### 7. Exempt Party-In-Interest Transactions

The investment contract is managed by a trustee of the Plan. Therefore, these transactions qualify as exempt party-in-interest transactions under ERISA.

Participants who are active employees may borrow from their accounts and such loans qualify as exempt party-in-interest transactions under ERISA. These loans are recorded as notes receivable from participants on the statements of net assets available for benefits.

Certain administrative functions of the Plan are performed by officers or employees of the Company. No such officer or employee receives compensation from the Plan.

### 8. Prohibited Transactions.

In 2023, the Company failed to remit to the Plan certain participants' contributions totaling \$204 within the period described by the Department of Labor's regulations. Delays in remitting the contributions to the Plan were due to administrative oversight. During 2025, the Company made the necessary corrections to satisfy both the Department of Labor and IRS guidance.

### 9. Risks and Uncertainties

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks such as interest rate, market, and credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect participants' account balances and the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits.
