SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE NEAL LAW GROUP RETIREMENT PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report Form 5500 Annual Return/Report of Small Employee Benefit Plan of THE NEAL LAW GROUP RETIREMENT PLAN and Employer Identification Number 86-3590456/Plan Number 001 for the plan year 01/01/2025 through 12/31/2025. The Form 5500-SF annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA). Your plan is a single employer, defined contribution plan with the following characteristics: employer contributions, profit sharing, ERISA section 404(c), total participant-directed account, code section 401(k) feature, code section 401(m) arrangement, total or partial participant-directed account, covered by self-employed individuals, pre-approved pension.

Basic Financial Statement

Plan expenses were \$0. These expenses included \$0 in administrative expenses and \$0 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries, and \$0 in other expenses. A total of 6 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year, although not all of these persons had yet earned the right to receive benefits.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$571,966 as of the end of the plan year, compared to \$430,916 as of the beginning of the plan year. During the plan year the plan experienced a change in its net assets of \$141,050. This change includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$141,050, including employer contributions of \$10,208, employee contributions of \$51,376, other contributions/other income of \$0 and earnings from investments of \$79,466.

Information Regarding Plan Assets

The U.S. Department of Labor's regulations require that an independent qualified public accountant audit the plan's financial statements unless certain conditions are met for the audit requirement to be waived. This plan met the audit waiver conditions for the plan year beginning 01/01/2025 and therefore has not had an audit performed.

The plan's assets were held in individual participant accounts with investments directed by participants and beneficiaries and with account statements from regulated financial institutions furnished to the participant or beneficiary at least annually and other qualifying assets.

It is designed to limit the extent to which elective deferrals (pre-tax and Roth, if applicable) and matching contributions are allocated on behalf of highly compensated employees (HCEs) may exceed the contributions of the non-highly compensated employees (NHCEs). The tests compare the average rates of the two groups of employees. Test Results: N/A: The plan meets the Safe Harbor requirements and this test is not necessary.
Top Heavy Test	Defined contribution plan is top heavy if, as of the determination date, the total of the account balances of all key employees exceeds 60% of the total of the account of all of the employees as outlined in Internal Revenue Code §416. Maximum Deferral Limit	The dollar amount of elective deferrals a participant can contribute during a calendar year is limited based on the Internal Revenue Code §402(g). This limit applies to all plans in which the employee participates, even if not maintained by the same employer. The limit for 2025 was \$23,500. Plan participants who are at least age 50 are eligible to make additional catch-up contributions. The maximum catch-up amount was \$7,500. Test Results: Passed
Minimum Coverage Test	Your plan is required to pass the minimum coverage test as outlined in Internal Revenue Code §410(b). The percentage of non-highly compensated employees (NHCEs) benefitting must be at least 70% of the percentage of highly compensated employees (HCEs) benefitting in the plan. This is the Ratio Percentage test. Coverage may be satisfied by the Average Benefits test if the Ratio Percentage test fails. ABG verifies this test annually. Annual Additions	Internal Revenue Code §415(c) limits the total amount of contributions that may be allocated to an individual's account in any limitation year.
